- All refundable deposits (Laboratory, Caution Money and Library etc.) shall be refunded at the time of cancellation.
- Provided that wherever admissions are made through centralised admission process for professional and/or for any other courses by other competent authorities (as per the rules of relevant agencies) for the 1st year admissions. In case of admission to subsequent years of the course, **0.2859** is applicable for cancellation of admission.
 - Provided further that this refund rule is concurrent with the rules and guidelines of other professional statutory bodies appointed for admission for relevant courses.
